I am providing the following comments regarding paper DIS -16-03:

1. Have you considered the safety problems as outlined by DR. Michele Mosca (Perimeter Institute upcoming lecture, Kitchener, Oct 5th, 2016) concerning the very real possibility of computer breakdowns? In the event of no electricity for an extended period of time, such as three-six months or longer, how do you intend to continue the necessary cooling down processes involved in the nuclear industry?
2. I would like to point out that Angela Merkel, chancellor of Germany, was trained as a nuclear chemist and that she has banned the nuclear industry in Germany, for reasons that many of us are probably not even aware.
3. How do you justify the safety of the nuclear industry when there are reactors on the shores of 20% of the world's fresh water, here in Ontario? How can you justify the safety of these waters when an accident like the one at Fukushima or Chernobyl would undoubtedly contaminate?
