# *Notice of Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in September to consider the request from New Brunswick Power Nuclear (NBPN) to transfer the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station (PLNGS) operating licence to New Brunswick Power Corporation. The PLNGS is located on the Lepreau Peninsula, 40 km southwest of Saint John, New Brunswick.

NBPN's application is to ensure alignment with the new New Brunswick *Electricity Act*, which received Royal Assent from the New Brunswick Legislature on June 21, 2013 and is expected to come into force on October 1, 2013.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this request from NBPN. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and NBPN.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
