# *Revised Notice of Public Hearing and Participant Funding*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces changes to the public hearing date to consider an application from the Ontario Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) seeking the release of the Deloro Mine site from CNSC licensing, through an exemption under the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act* and its associated regulations.

The public hearing will now take place on August 16 or 17, 2017 instead of June 21 or 22, 2017 as originally announced. This change affects the submission deadlines for participant funding applications and requests to intervene.

Place: CNSC public hearing room, 14th floor, 280 Slater Street, Ottawa, ON  
Time: As set by the agenda published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcast live and available for 90 days on the CNSC website at [nuclearsafety.gc.ca](http://nuclearsafety.gc.ca).

Through its Participant Funding Program, the CNSC is offering up to **\$35,000** in funding to assist members of the public, Indigenous groups and other stakeholders in reviewing the MOECC's application and associated documents, and in participating in the Commission hearing process by providing topic-specific interventions to the Commission. The deadline to submit a participant funding application form to the CNSC is **April 3, 2017**.

Members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment on the MOECC's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **July 17, 2017** using the [online request form](#) or following the coordinates below. Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, **the request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only, or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions are available to the public on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you

wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

The MOECC's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at the hearing will be available after June 14, 2017. To obtain copies of these documents, please contact the Secretariat at the coordinates below or request them directly from the website.
