



Revised Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces the location and a date change for Part 2 of the public hearing to consider an application from New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power) for a five-year renewal of its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station.

In light of the number of interventions to be considered during Part 2 of the public hearing, one day (May 9) has been added.

Part 1 of the public hearing was held in Ottawa on January 26, 2017.
