# *Revised Notice of Public Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is announcing a change to the location of the public hearing to consider the application from BWXT Nuclear Energy Canada Inc. (BWXT) to renew its Class IB fuel facility operating licence for a period of 10 years. The CNSC is also announcing a change to the expected duration of the hearing. Under its current licence, BWXT operates two separate facilities: one in Toronto and one in Peterborough, Ontario.

**Date:** March 4 and 5, 2020 (if required, the hearing will continue on March 6)  
**Place:** Regency Ballroom, Holiday Inn Peterborough Waterfront,  
150 George Street North, Peterborough, Ontario  
**Time:** As set by the agenda, to be published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at [nuclearsafety.gc.ca](http://nuclearsafety.gc.ca). **Participation in the public hearing through videoconferencing will be available from the Havilland Hall, Holiday Inn Toronto Yorkdale, 3450 Dufferin Street, Toronto, Ontario.**

Pursuant to rule 19 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment on BWXT's application and associated documents. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **January 27, 2020**, using the [online request form](#) or the contact information below. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

BWXT's licence renewal application is posted on its [website](#). BWXT's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations, which will also be considered by the Commission at the hearing, will be available on the CNSC website or upon request to the Secretariat after **December 19, 2019**.

To assist Indigenous peoples, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing BWXT's application and associated documents, and as previously set out in the Notice of Hearing published on June 3, 2019, participant funding of up to \$50,000 was made available through the CNSC's [Participant Funding Program](#). The deadline to submit a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC was September 3, 2019.
