The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) makes legislative, policy and administrative decisions in accordance with the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*.

Following a public meeting of the Commission held on December 11, 2008, in Ajax, Ontario, the Commission made the following decision:

1. Approval of the Regulatory Document RD-364, *Joint Canada – United States Guide for Approval of Type B (U) and Fissile Material Transportation Packages*, for publication and use. English and French versions of RD-364 will be made available on the CNSC Web site at a later date.

The minutes for the December 11 meeting will include the above item and be tabled for the approval of the Commission at the next scheduled meeting on January 14, 2009. The approved minutes will be available soon thereafter, on the CNSC Web site or by contacting the CNSC.
